#### Over \$14,900 gifted between nine local nonprofits

For many the holidays will be a little brighter. Between public donations totaling \$8,228.55 and Prevail Bank matching up to \$1,000 at each branch location, a grand total of \$14,926.10 was gifted between nine organizations as part of Prevail Bank's Holiday Matching Funds campaign this December.

Surrounded by Prevail Bank co-workers, Branch Manager Kori Milller (center) presented a \$1,342 check to Hope Hospice professionals Ashley Stillman, Executive Assistant (standing to Miller's left) and Nicole Syryczuk, Executive Director (standing to Miller's right). Half of the funds were donated by the public; Prevail Bank matched that total, gifting \$671.

The nine nonprofits that received critical funding, raising hope and happiness of their clients were: Sauk County

Children's Giving Tree \$1,390. Marshfield Area Pet Shelter \$1,060, Hope Hospice (Medford) \$1,342, Catkins Animal Rescue (Phillips) \$2,106.
